The Mission of the Mile Hi Veterans Education Committee shall be to provide scholarships and other educational benefits to Veterans, members, and their families.

ELIGIBILTY:

Applicants MUST meet **ALL** the following requirements:

- High school senior, graduate, or GED recipient, or continuing post-secondary student.
- Hispanic background or involvement with the Hispanic community.
- Accepted for enrollment for the Fall Semester in a certificate, vocational, or degree program.
- Minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average (GPA) or GED completion.
- Colorado resident and a citizen or permanent resident of the United States.
- A Veteran, Mile Hi Veteran member or a family member for at least one full year.
- Letters of recommendation **MUST** be current. If the individual wants to send the letter directly to the committee, please have them email it directly by the deadline.
- Applicant must comply with ALL requirements, if for any reason the application is incomplete or is not turned in on or before the deadline that applicant will be ineligible.

STUDENT CHECKLIST:

Your application packet MUST include ALL the following:
1. Mile Hi Veterans Scholarship Application
2. A copy of your high school or GED certificate or post-secondary institution academic transcript.
3. Typed 250–500-word double spaced essay.
4. Letter of enrollment/acceptance from the post-secondary institution you plan to attend in Fall Semester
5. Two non-family letters of recommendation (from a teacher/mentor/religious or community leader).
Letters must discuss your academic achievement, leadership, community service, and your potential to be
successful in the future. Letters must also be CURRENT to the academic year and RECEIVED by the deadline
