

Montbello High School – Latino Veterans Presentations

We have been invited to participate as speakers on a panel to present on the topic of Latino/Hispanic Veterans to 9th and 10th graders. Many of the students in the classes are Latino and speak a combination of English and Spanish. **We will be presenting six (6), fifty-four-minute classes ranging from 20-50 students in size.** Individual presentations will be **5-10 minutes** long depending on the number of speakers in the classroom. A Question & answer session will follow the presentations. Our sharing of personal military experiences will bring history to life. Latin/Hispanic wartime experiences are specifically part of the curriculum's current unit of study.
